

## General corona measures Stedelijk Museum Coevorden

(according to the protocol of the Dutch Museum Association:

### Museumvereniging) Adjustments 30 september 2020

- Special corona rules have been drawn up for our employees and volunteers.
- Special corona rules have been drawn up for our visitors.
- The rules and general measures are adjusted in accordance with the most recent RIVM guidelines. This may have consequences for the opening hours of the museum.
- Stedelijk Museum Coevorden reserves the right to refuse access for visitors, suppliers or employees to the museum if there is any doubt about the state of their health.
- Sufficient employees have been appointed who are responsible for compliance with the protocol and who actively monitor this.
- An officer has been appointed who is responsible for compliance with the protocol and who actively monitors if visitors and employers are living up to the protocol. In the case of the Stedelijk Museum Coevorden, the director has been appointed for this position.
- Visitors who do not live up to this protocol are requested to end their visit.
- The maximum simultaneous number of museum visitors is 15 people.
- Visitors are obligated to make an online reservation at [www.museumcoevorden.nl](http://www.museumcoevorden.nl) Online and at the reception desk, we will ask if visitors have any COVID-19 related complaints. If you have any complaints, we will refuse your visit.
- We maintain the selection of timeslots in order to control the maximum capacity of 15 visitors at the same time.
- It is only allowed to come to the museum with more than 1 person if it concerns a group of one household.
- Every visitor is obliged to bring a map with the route and rules into the museum. These are handed out at the reception. Follow the arrows in the museum. There are 15 roadmaps.
- The number of visitors allowed per room is indicated on the map and on the doors/rooms.
- Employees can be recognized by an orange vest.
- In the museum store, visitors pay by card.
- The Archeolab/ children's corner is closed.
- Visitors can only use the toilets on the ground floor.
- The lift is only used by disabled people or personnel.
- You can only make photo's or video's according to article 3.5 in our standard visitor conditions.
- No groups and school visits will be received until September 1. Tours and special group offers cannot be booked.
- Extra hygienic measures are taken, such as:
  - Disinfectants, screens, etc.
  - Cleaning protocol for volunteers/employees.
  - Extra attention to disinfection in the regular cleaning program.
- • The Cultural-historical pavilion is closed: the pavilion will be used from mid-June as an exhibition space that can only be seen from the outside.
